Junior B  
(\* Short Program + Free Skate)

## PLACE AND DATE

The competition will be held on December 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> 2017 in Eindhoven, the Netherlands. All competition events will take place at the indoor figure skating ice rink (60x30 meters) at the ice sports center, Eindhoven.

## CLOSING DATE OF ENTRY

November 20<sup>th</sup> 2017, 23:59h

## ACCREDITATION

Will be possible on Saturday December 9<sup>th</sup> from approx. 06:45h on at the ice rink.

## PRACTICE SESSION

There is a practice session available for international entries only on Friday the 8<sup>th</sup> of December, from 18.00-18.45h. Please contact the competition secretary if you would like to subscribe one or more skaters (first come, first serve).

## DRAW

Will be applied to all categories by a computer generated system producing the starting order. The draw for the starting order of the Advanced Novice A Free Skate will commence directly after the Short Program skate in the judges room. This draw will commence by hand, all competitors in the category are expected to attend.

## TIME TABLE

Will be made available on the website as soon as possible after the closing date. Changes may occur due to technical requirements of the judging system and/or exceeding number of entries.

## JUDGES AND/OR TECHNICAL SPECIALISTS

For international entries; please inform the organizing committee in case you're considering adding a judge and/or technical specialist to the competition. These request will then be made known to the Dutch Skating Federation. All categories will be judged with the IJS (judging system, but without video replay/review option).

## GENERAL REGULATIONS

The competition will be conducted in accordance with ISU Regulations 2016 and all recent communications for figure skating (single skating). All categories abide to regulations according to the ISU judging system and will be judged as such. All competitors must be eligible persons in accordance with ISU Rule 102 and must meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in ISU rule 109 and communication no 1117. All skaters who do not have nationality of the member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another member, must produce an ISU clearance certificate.

## COMPETITION

### *MUSIC*

Only CDs are accepted (no re-writable CD or mp3). The recording must be of good quality and the CD labelled clearly with the name of competitor, category and skating club/country abbreviations. A copy of the CD must be handed in at the accreditation desk anywhere in between first arrival up to preferably one hour before the start of the skater's category. The CD quality cannot be tested beforehand, therefore a second copy should always be available for technical staff in case a technical issue should arise during the competition.

### *PRIZES*

Each of the winning competitors will be presented with a trophy. Also, during the victory ceremony all competitors are invited on to the ice in order to receive a memento. The protocol will be uploaded on to the homepage immediately after the closing of the competition. Clubmembers or coaches are allowed to collect trophies that belong to participants that were forced to leave early before completion of the victory ceremony.

## *ACCOMODATION AND TRANSPORTATION*

Accommodation as well as transportation from and to the ice rink has to be organized by the participant. However, please feel free to contact our organizing committee with any questions. ## LIABILITY

The organizing committee holds no liability for injuries or damage sustained by competitors on any competition day.

## ENTRY FORM

Please use the official entry form, stating both first and last name of the participant as well as the date of birth.

## LIMITATIONS

The organization is adhering to the requirements listed by the Dutch Skating Union (dep. of figure skating) in providing an additional qualifying event for Dutch skaters entering following categories: *Mini, Midi, Maxi, Pre Basic Novice B, Basic Novice B, Advanced Novice B and Junior B*. The entries for these categories will be unlimited for Dutch entries. The results in these categories by Dutch members can therefore be used to qualify for the Dutch national finals.

The organization committee reserves the right to limit the entries for the remaining categories: *Pre Basic Novice A, Basic Novice A, Advanced Novice A*. Entries in these categories will be accepted on a first come, first served basis; up to the maximum in relation to the available competition hours. The organizing club will follow the order mentioned by the clubs on their entry form. Following rules of entry apply to all participating clubs:

- Every club has the right to enter a maximum of **2** skaters in each category (Boys & Girls). Also, every club may register only 2 additional skater as back-up (for Dutch entries via Figure Skating Online, please enter these skaters under 'substitute'). This skater may only replace the original entry for the competition before the results of the first draw or can be added by the organizing club only in case the competition schedule allows more entries overall.
- The organizing club has the right to enter an unlimited number of participants in all categories.

## ENTRANCE FEE

The payment must be made in full by November 30<sup>th</sup>. No refunds can be given.

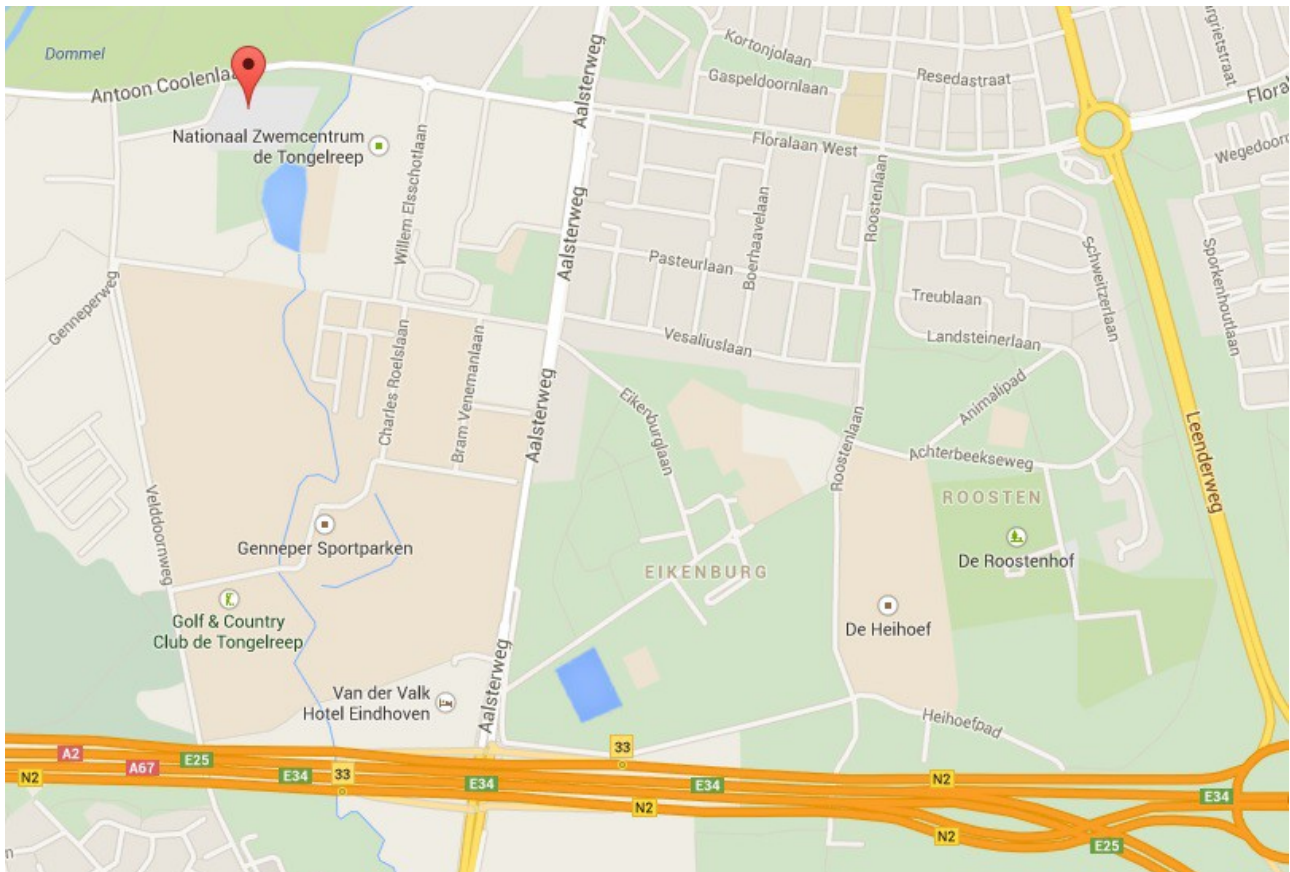

### **Mini**

Ages boys & girls: up to the age of 10 yrs

### **Midi**

Ages boys & girls: between 11-13 yrs old

Ages boys & girls: 14+ yrs

1. – 4.: A maximum of 4 jumps, one of which must be an Axel-type jump (allowed are 2 jumpcombinations or -sequences; a jumpcombination can not consist of more than two jumps)
- 5.: Combination spin with (min. of 8 revolutions) or without change of foot (min. of 6 revolutions), flying entry allowed
- 6.: Spin in one basic position; change of foot is allowed (min. of 6 revolutions)
- 7.: Max. 1 step sequence; a series of steps covering the entire length of the ice rink

### **Advanced Novice B**

Ages boys & girls: 15+ yrs

Dutch entries: MIF Intergoud

Free Skate only

Music time:

Girls: 3:00 minutes +/- 10 seconds

Boys: 3:30 minutes +/- 10 seconds

Free Skate content:

1.-6./7.: A maximum of 6 jumps \*for Girls / 7 jumps \*for Boys, one (1) of which must be an Axel-type jump (allowed are 2 jump combinations or sequences; a jump combination can not consist of more than two jumps, triple jumps are allowed; only 2 jumps of 2 ½ or more rotations may be repeated)

7./8.: Combination spin with or without change of foot (min. 8 revolutions), flying entry allowed.

8./9.: Flying spin (min. 6 revolutions) or spin with flying entry in one position with one change of foot (min. 8 revolutions)

9./10.: Max. 1 step sequence; a series of steps covering the entire length of the ice rink

### **Junior B**

Ages boys & girls: 19+ yrs

Dutch entries: MIF Goud

Free Skate only

Music time:

Girls: 3:30 minutes +/- 10 seconds

Boys: 4:00 minutes +/- 10 seconds

Free Skate content:

1.-7./8.: A maximum of 7 jumps \*for Girls / 8 jumps \*for Boys, one (1) of which must be an Axel-type jump (allowed are 3 jump combinations or sequences; one jump combination may consist of three jumps)

8./9.: Combination spin

9./10.: Flying spin (in one position) or combination spin with flying entry

10./11.: Spin in one position

11./12.: Max. 1 step sequence; a series of steps covering the entire length of the ice rink

### **Pre Basic Novice A**

Ages boys & girls: up to the age of 11 yrs

Dutch entries: MIF Interzilver

Free Skate only

Music time: 2.30 minutes +/- 10 seconds

### **Basic Novice A**

Ages boys & girls: between 10-12 yrs old

Dutch entries: MIF Zilver

Free Skate only

Music time: 2.30 minutes +/- 10 seconds

### **Free skate content: Pre Basic Novice A, Basic Novice A**

1. – 4.: A maximum of 4 jumps, one of which must be an Axel-type jump (allowed are 2 jump combinations or -sequences; a jump combination can not consist of more than two jumps, triple jumps are not allowed)

5.: Combination spin with (min. of 8 revolutions) or without change of foot (min. of 6 revolutions), flying entry allowed

6.: Spin in one basic position with (min. of 8 revolutions) or without change of foot (min. of 6 revolutions), flying entry allowed

7.: Max. 1 step sequence; a series of steps covering the entire length of the ice rink

## **Advanced Novice A**

Ages boys & girls: between 10-14 yrs old

Dutch entries: MIF Intergoud

Music time SP: Girls & Boys: 2.20 minutes +/- 10 seconds

Music time FS: Girls: 3:00 minutes +/- 10 seconds

Boys: 3:30 minutes +/- 10 seconds

### Short Program content:

1.: Axel or double Axel

2.: Double or triple jump out of consecutive steps (not Axel)

3.: Combination of double + triple jump or double + double jump (no repetition of jumps under 1. or 2. allowed)

4 - *BOYS*: Spin in one position with change of foot (min. of 5 revolutions per foot), flying entry not allowed

- *GIRLS*: Spin in layback or other basic position with no change of foot (min. of 6 revolutions)

5. Combination spin; max. one change of foot is allowed (min. 5 revolutions per foot), flying entry allowed

6.: Max. 1 step sequence; a series of steps covering the entire length of the ice rink

### Free Skate content:

1.-6./7.: A maximum of 6 jumps \*for Girls / 7 jumps \*for Boys, one (1) of which must be an Axel-type jump (allowed are 2 jump combinations or sequences; a jump combination can not consist of more than two jumps, triple jumps are allowed; only 2 jumps of 2 ½ or more rotations may be repeated)

7./8.: Combination spin with change of foot (min. 8 revolutions), flying entry not allowed.

8./9.: Flying spin (min. 6 revolutions) or spin with flying entry in one position, change of foot allowed (min. 8 revolutions)

9./10.: Max. 1 step sequence; a series of steps covering the entire length of the ice rink
